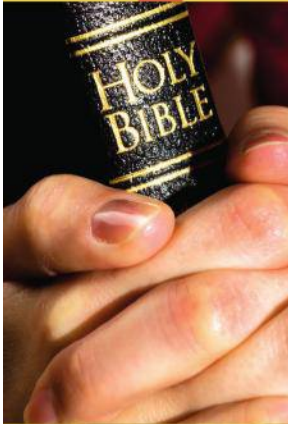

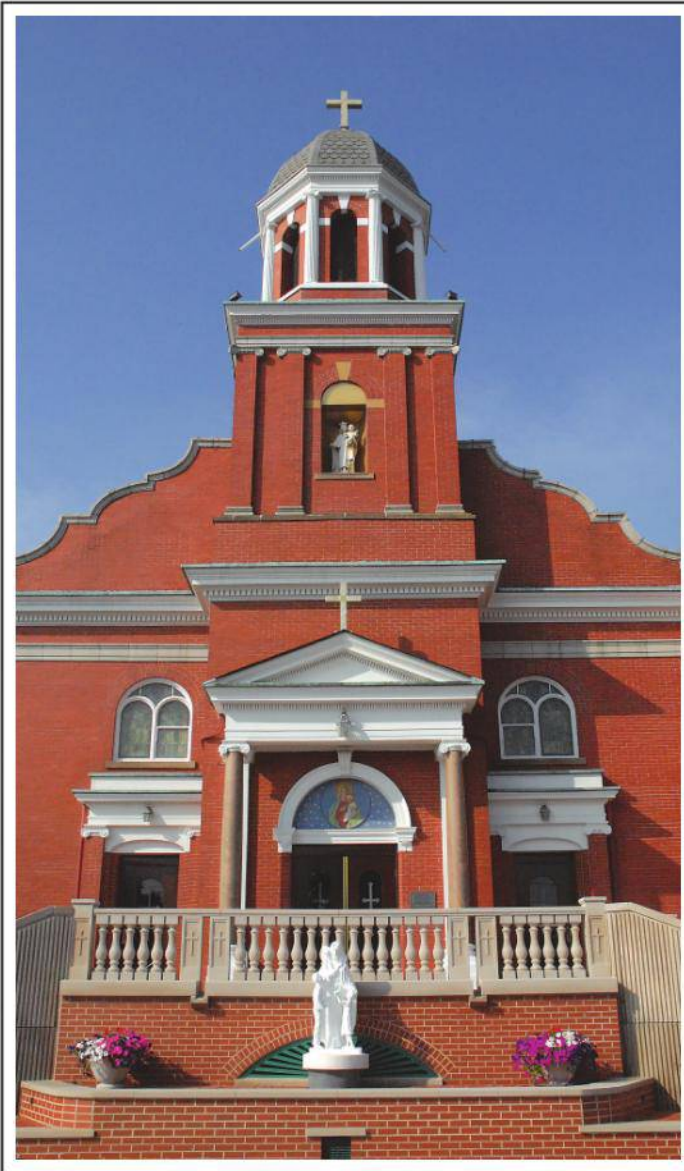

Creation. That people may learn to respect creation and care for it as a gift of God. **Persecuted Christians.** That persecuted Christians may feel the consoling presence of the Risen Lord and the solidarity of all the Church.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel
3. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
4. October 17th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary (chosen personally by Bishop Murry)
5. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the faithful on the day of the anniversary of the dedication of the basilica. (to be announced).

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis. On most of the above days I will make sure that a priest is available for sacramental confessions and I hope to announce these special days in advance so that the Faithful may plan their calendar. God's choicest blessing upon you in the summer Festival Days of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and a special thank you to all the volunteers.

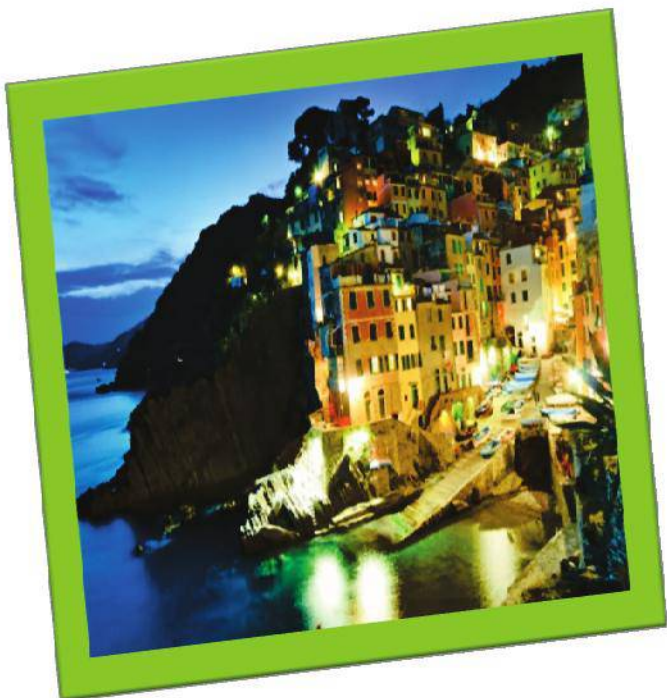

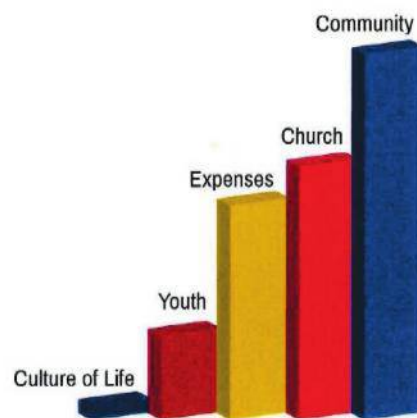
