EASTER SUNDAY TODAY'S FOCUS: BEING AN EASTER WITNESS

The Easter scriptures give us many role models to be people who give witness to the Resurrection. We must overcome fear and boldly speak what we have come to know through faith.

In the Easter Sequence we sing "Speak, Mary, declaring what you saw, wayfaring." Speaking what one see, observes, and hears is a good definition for being a witness. Mary Magdalene was the first witness to the Resurrection, which is why she is call the "Apostle to the Apostles" and is patron of the Order of Preachers. (Dominicans)
