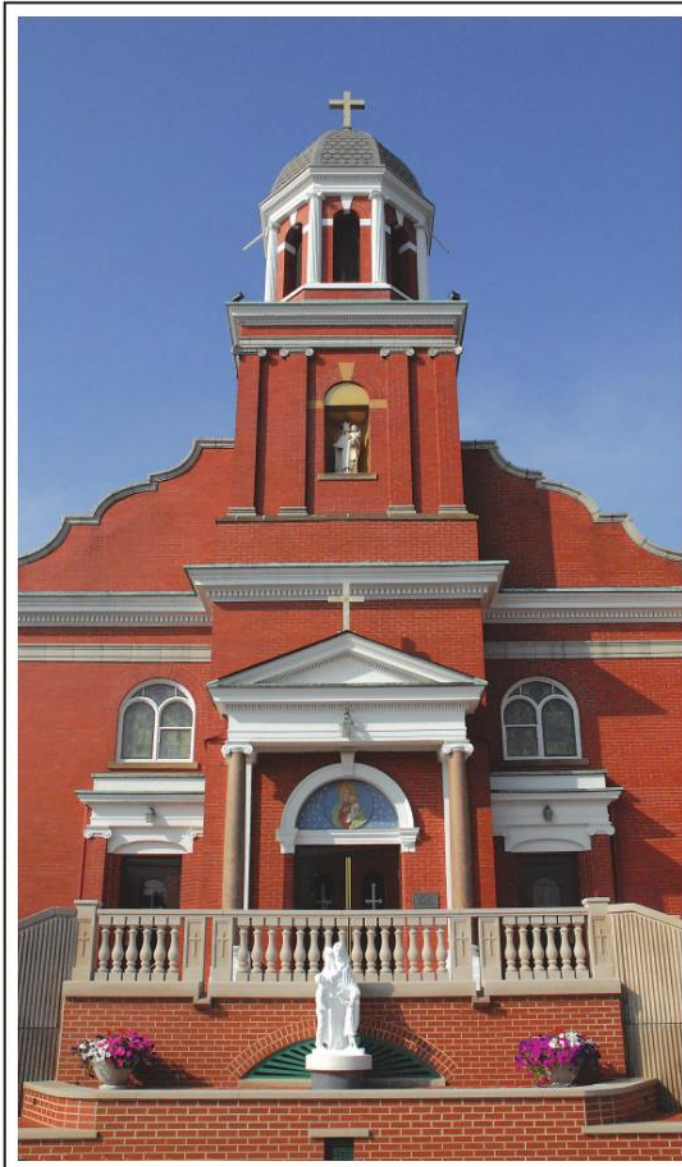

Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

Last week as we celebrated the fifth Sunday of the Easter season and opened Msgr. Cariglio's decree of our basilica's Year of Mary, I spoke of the hymn "Be Joyful, Mary, Heavenly Queen." It was our opening hymn last weekend, and since its theme fulfills both the Easter message and our devotion to Mary, it is our closing hymn this weekend. The source of the text of this hymn comes from the Gregorian Chant "Regina Caeli, laetare" (O Queen of Heaven, be Joyful). The Orthodox Church also uses a similar text for the song of Mary, "O Angelos Evoa" (The angel cried to her who was filled with grace, exclaiming: "Rejoice, O purest Virgin"). This weekend's prelude is an arrangement of this melody.

I have mentioned the *liturgical judgment* that music ministers must consider when choosing hymns for Mass; that is, how the hymns and music should fit the theme of the weekend's readings. This week's Gospel continues the theme of commission and comfort of Jesus to his apostles before his death, resurrection, and ascension. He tells us today that if we commit to his law of love, he will not leave us comfortless, that the spirit of truth will come to us. This transitions us liturgically towards the Ascension and Pentecost. Because of this message of love and comfort, we sing "We Have Been Told" as the offertory hymn this weekend. We have seen the face of God through his teachings and his love poured out on the cross; now we have to bring that message of love into the world so we can receive the spirit at Pentecost.
