Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16h Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 17th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the faithful.

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.

On the above days, I plan to announce these special days in advance so that the Faithful may mark their calendar. God's choicest blessing upon you in this Special Year of Mary, May 17, 2017-May 13, 2018 the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.

#### Craig's Corner A Note from our Director of Music

As Catholics, we are no strangers to Gregorian Chant. These melodies, sung practically since the beginning of the Church, are a unique sentiment to our faith. One way these chant melodies were sung in Church history, was that of the Chant Mass verses. This was a common practice in the French Baroque period of the 1600-1700s. One verse would be sung by the choir, followed by an organ verse which have different melodies (although often the melody is hidden in the first organ verse), often highlighting the different sounds of the instrument. The chant melody, Veni Creator Spiritus, the text of the Pentecost Sequence, and its subsequent verses composed by Nicolas de Grigny in 1699, are used as the prelude for our Pentecost Sunday Masses.

The postlude also carries the melody of this chant but in a **much** more modern way. Larry King's (no, not that Larry King) "Fanfares to the Tongues of Fire" puts a vivid setting of this melody before us in his composition. The piece alternates between loud clusters of the melody, a direct statement of the melody, and a celestial softer statement of the melody. The loud section where the melody becomes a cluster of notes symbolizes what we heard proclaimed in the Sunday readings, there was much confusion when the tongues of fire came upon the apostles. After the direct statement of the melody, a fanfare of trumpets signal the joyous occasion of this celebration – the birthday of the Church! With this feast we celebrate the end of our fifty days of Easter. It is my hope that the music and our celebrations of Lent, the Triduum, and Easter have brought you to a deeper faith in Christ.


