




IN THIS YEAR OF MARY, JUNE 11TH Mary, The Virgin Mother of Grace

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the faithful.

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.

On the above days, I plan to announce these special days in advance so that the Faithful may mark their calendar. God's choicest blessing upon you in this Special Year of Mary, May 17, 2017-May 13, 2018 the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY



"Glory be to the Father, to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end, amen." This prayer, the Glory be or Gloria Patri, has been part of Christianity since its beginnings, as St. Paul often praises the Trinity in these or similar words in many of his writings. The term for this praise of God is doxology. While we pray these words when reciting the rosary and at other times in prayer, adaptations of this doxology are found in many hymns and psalms as a final verse. One of many examples is our opening hymn this weekend, Come, Our Almighty King: verse 1 praises God as Father, verse 2 praises Jesus the incarnate Word, verse 3 praising the Spirit as comforter, and verse 4 is the doxology, praising the One in Three, the eternal Trinity forevermore. While this weekend's solemnity of the Trinity calls special attention to the Triune God, we praise the Trinity each time we pray and begin our Masses. Can you think of other hymns (there are many) whose final verse serves as a doxology?

I would also like to welcome Abbey Eash to offer her gift of music to the basilica this weekend. Abbey just completed seventh grade at Boardman Glenwood Junior High. For the offertory and preparation of the Altar at two of our Masses this weekend, she will be playing Bach's Bourrée. To continue the works of Bach, the prelude and postlude this weekend are Bach's Fugue in E-Flat Major, set to the *St. Anne* hymn tune, the melody we use after Lent for the *Saint Anthony, We Turn to Thee* hymn at the weekly Novena Masses. As we anticipate St. Anthony Day as a parish this coming Tuesday, this piece honors his feast. There are three sections: the first encompasses the entire melody, whereas the second and third contain only fragments of the melody. The first and second sections are the prelude, while the final section is the postlude.


