FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the Catechism of the Catholic Church: An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfaction of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th-the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, apostles
3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel
4. October 17 the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
5. December 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the faithful.

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.

On the above days, I plan to announce these special days in advance so that the Faithful may mark their calendar. God's choicest blessing upon you in this Special Year of Mary, May 17, 2017-May 13, 2018 the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.
