Dear Friends in Christ,
From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the **Catechism of the Catholic Church:**

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the faithful.

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.

On the above days, I plan to announce these special days in advance so that the Faithful may mark their calendar. God's choicest blessing upon you in this Special Year of Mary, May 17, 2017-May 13, 2018 the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.

Craig's Corner
A Note from our Director of Music

Many times I write about the importance of the Psalms in our Liturgy. Just as Liturgical roles are assigned to other leaders, such as altar servers, lectors, ushers, etc., the psalmist's role is to proclaim the Psalm and often the Gospel Acclamation and verse as well. The Church documents on music and the structure of the Liturgy call for the psalmist to proclaim the Psalm and Gospel verse from the ambo so that they can visibly communicate the text, or another suitable place. If the psalmist is also the organist, the Psalm is often sung from the organ. Taken directly from the document "Sing to the Lord," the psalmist's main role is to "proclaim the text of the Psalm with clarity, conviction, and sensitivity to the text, the musical setting, and those who are listening."

As director of music, I invite some of our gifted voices from the congregation step forward to become a psalmist for any of our weekend Masses. If you are interested in this ministry, please contact me at 330-770-6504 or see me after any weekend Mass. Simple training would be required, as the verses of the psalms are sung with composed psalm tones in the key of the refrain.

Also for anyone interested in singing in our joint choir for the Feast Day Mass at noon on July 16, please contact me! We will have two rehearsals on Wednesday July 5 and 12 in the basilica at 7pm. We will be happy to have you to honor Our Lady of Mount Carmel, in an even more special way in this year of Mary.
