FEAST OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

This feast honors the intercessory power of Mary as manifested in the benefits granted to wearers of Her Scapular. It was approved by Pope Sixtus V, in 1587 for the Carmelite Order. It was made a feast for the entire Church by Pope Benedict XIII, in 1726.

The feast, also called the Commemoration of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, brings to mind the brown Scapular of the Blessed Virgin. In its origin, the Feast had no direct Connection with the Scapular, but was instituted by the Carmelites to celebrate the Church's approval of their rule. The Feast is linked with the Scapular through the day on which it is kept. July 16th is the traditionally accepted date on which the Blessed Mother appeared to Simon Stock and presented to him the Scapular in token of Her protection. It is said that the Blessed Mother gave the Scapular to Simon Stock in 1251.


