





<u>Craig's Corner</u> A Note from our Director of Music

One of my other loves in the world, aside from the Church and my job as music director for our basilica, is the weather. I actually have three undergraduate degrees: a Bachelor of Arts in Religious Studies from Youngstown State, a Bachelor of Music in Organ Performance also from YSU, and a Bachelor of Science in Applied Meteorology from Mississippi State University. I am about to begin my second year of distance learning coursework at Mississippi State for my Masters of Geosciences in Meteorology as well.

Why do I bring this up? This weekend we notice a major theme in the readings to be two opposite facets of our God: calm and peace versus power and dominion. A blessing (or a curse) of the weather in our valley is that we experience not only the calm and peaceful days, but also the powerful and awe-inspiring storms. In the first reading today we hear of Elijah waiting for God in the strong winds, the fires, and the earthquakes; he instead hears God in a tiny whispering sound. In the Gospel, Jesus' disciples become afraid in a large storm with strong winds and high waves at sea and for a time, lack faith in trusting in His calming hand. Once they experience both the fury and the calm, they proclaim Him as truly being the Son of God.

Our music this weekend gives us glimpses at both sides of these accounts: the peace and the power. The prelude, Jean Langlais' *Song of Peace*, our offertory hymn *On Eagle's Wings* and *Draw Near* at communion, show the more peaceful, calming, and caring side of our God. Conversely, the opening hymn *All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name* (Hymn Tune: *Coronation*) and its associated postlude focus on God's kingship and power that we acclaim, as did the apostles today in the Gospel, that Jesus is truly the Son of God.




