

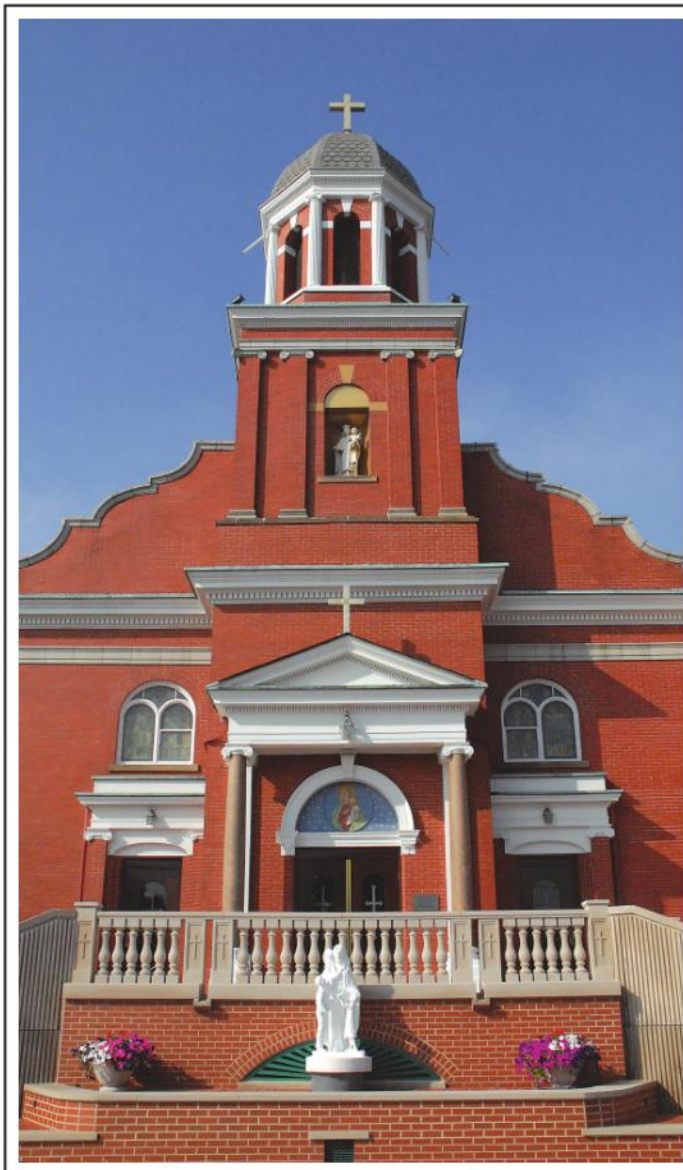

Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

Msgr. Cariglio preached on the meaning of vocations last weekend as our focus centered on lifting up our crosses in life towards Christ himself. To continue this sentiment, this weekend we hear the theme of love. St. Paul in his letter to the Romans reminds us that the commandments are summed up by our love for one another. Jesus continues this message as he tells us in the Gospel to settle our faults with each other. We must use our vocations in this life, whether married, clergy, or single, to praise and love God and one another. As we sing the Psalm this weekend we pray that we hear this voice of God calling us to his way, we should not harden our hearts to hear this message. Our music centers on this message of love and keeping peace with our neighbors this weekend. The text of *Where Charity and Love Prevail*, our opening hymn, comes from the ancient chant text of *Ubi Caritas et Amor*, Jesus' message given to the apostles at the Last Supper that God is found when we show our love to one another. We hear the Gregorian Chant melody of the *Ubi Caritas* for the offertory this weekend.

A special way to praise our God is through our voices. I am very grateful to all of our parishioners who week in and week out participate very well in our Sunday Masses with singing. In another ministry, we have our wonderful dedicated choir. As director of music, I'd like to welcome back the choir next Sunday, September 17 at the 10AM Mass.
