



<u>Craig's Corner</u> A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend we begin a series of teachings and parables to us from Jesus about the kingdom of heaven. Our music, Psalms, and readings all speak of how we should focus first on Jesus and the kingdom as we go through our lives. We sing of being a priestly people, seeking the breath of God to come upon us, as we joyfully partake of our Sunday Eucharist to go forth to proclaim his kingdom on earth.

As I mentioned last week, during our festival this past summer, I was able to present our basilica's pipe organ to visitors and parishioners who took the basilica tours and so I wanted to write about it for the bulletin too. For the first part of my discussion of our organ, I want to offer some background on the history of the instruments in our basilica. It will come in two parts, this week being the first:

During the second pastorate of the parish, Monsignor Vito Franco, a fine Holkamp pipe organ was installed for the dedication of the church on November 4, 1916. The pipe organ was made possible by the famous Carnegie family of Pittsburgh. Due to the tragic fire in the church on June 12, 1923 it was badly damaged, but quickly restored for the rededication on December 16 of that year. During the pastorate of Fr. Henry Fabrizio, the pipe organ was in need of major repair. At the time, the parish was involved in the building of a new social hall and rectory. For financial reasons the Holkamp pipe organ was removed and replaced by an electronic instrument. The center arch of the choir loft was sealed to enshrine the church's crucifix which once hung at the present Sacred Heart Shrine. In 1973, Fr. Joseph Iati seized the opportunity to purchase from a church in West Virginia, a five rank pipe organ built in 1941 by the renowned MP Moeller Inc. of Hagerstown, MD. This was made possible through the generosity of brothers William and John Cafaro, The organ was expanded to eleven ranks by the David Dean Organ Company in New Castle, PA and installed in its new home.

This organ is not the organ in our basilica today. I will give more information about our current organ's history next week.
