Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

The first ecumenical council of the Catholic Church occurred in the year 325AD in Nicaea (which is in present-day Turkey). This council was called to convene Church leaders and discuss the doctrine of what we know of as the Trinity. It was in response to the Arian heresy proposing that Jesus was not divine but rather a created being. Eventually the end result of the council was the creed that we still say today at Mass, the Nicene Creed, condemning Arius and affirming our belief in the Trinity: one God in three equal persons. The location of Nicaea also became the hymn tune name for our opening hymn this weekend, "Holy, Holy, Holy," because its text praises the Trinity. The text also sets before us, as we begin Mass, the heart of the Scripture presented to us this weekend: *Only Thou art holy; there is none beside Thee*. Our Scriptures center on how we must worship nothing other than Him, the one true triune God. Isaiah reminds us of the commandment that there are no other gods besides the Lord. In our Gospel, Jesus tells the Pharisees who try to trick him into saying something against Caesar; Jesus sees through their plot and tells them to "repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." This is why the Psalmist today acclaims that we are to give God glory and honor. Our hymns today do just that, as we praise and worship the Trinity in our communion hymn "Panis Angelicus" and praise the name of God in our closing hymn "Holy God, we Praise thy Name," bowing only before God himself. And also, during this month dedicated to Mary and the Holy Rosary, our offertory procession this weekend honors her with an arrangement of the Gregorian Chant Ave Maria, or at the choir Mass, the hymn "Queen of the Holy Rosary."
