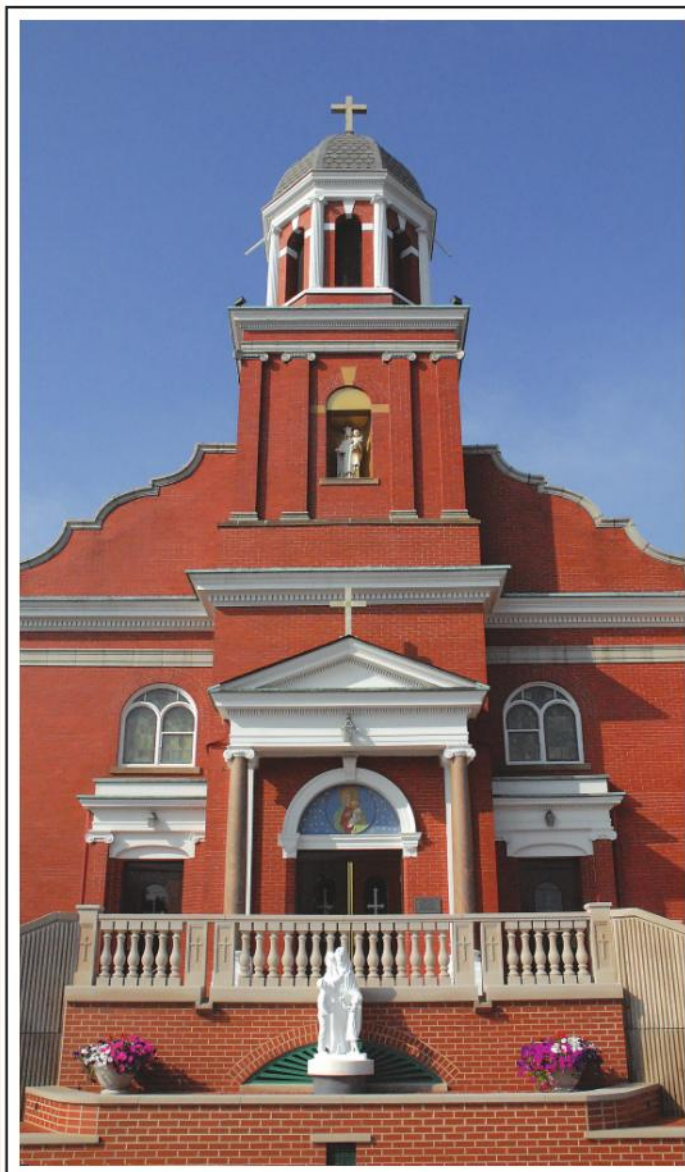

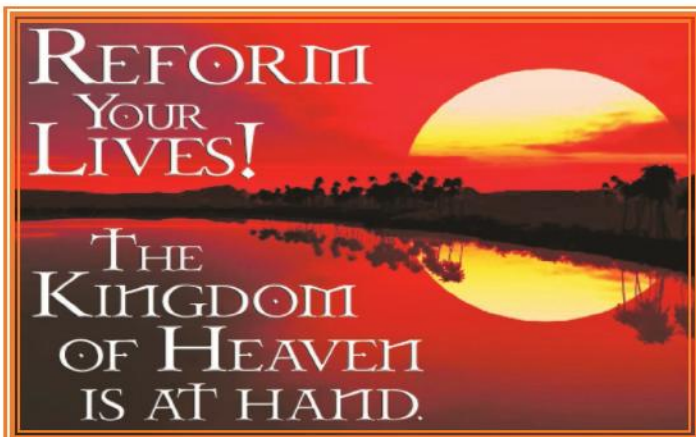

Yes, the Religious Education Office is done. All boxes and items are back in my office. They may not all be unpacked but I only need to look in my office to find whatever it is I am looking for!

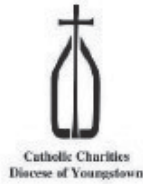

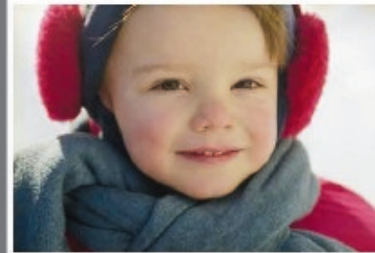

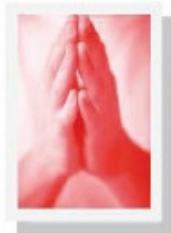

Epiphany Sunday, January 8, 2017

Note from the Music Director
Craig Ziobert

"The Gloria is a very ancient and venerable hymn in which the Church, gathered together in the Holy Spirit, glorifies and entreats God the Father and the Lamb. The priest, or the cantor or choir, intones the Gloria. It is sung by all, by the people alternately with the choir or cantor, or by the choir alone. 'The addition of refrains to the Glory to God is permitted, provided the refrains encourage congregational participation.' While through-composed settings of the Gloria give clearest expression to the text, the addition of refrains is permitted, provided the refrains encourage congregational participation."

These words taken from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' documents "Sing to The Lord" and "The General Instruction of the Roman Missal" offer insight into our singing of the Gloria during the Liturgical Year. The weekend of January 14-15, we added a refrain-based Gloria - the Melodic Gloria by James Chepponis - to our repertoire at Mt. Carmel. Beginning in 2017, the Rite of Marriage requires the Gloria to be sung at weddings, so it was decided that to foster additional participation by guests coming into the basilica for weddings, that having a Gloria with a refrain would be beneficial. Therefore, we will be singing this Gloria in addition to the other Gloria's we are accustomed to as a parish for Sunday celebrations. As a congregation, I am delighted at the amount of participation we receive each Liturgy and may we continue to move forward in growing spiritually through word and song in the years ahead.
