Craig's Corner
A Note from our Director of Music

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' document on the role of music in Catholic Liturgy, "Sing to the Lord," states the use of instrumental music during Mass is permissible and encouraged as part of the celebration. The document states: "Although instruments are used in Christian worship primarily to lead and sustain the singing, they may also, when appropriate, be played by themselves. Such instrumental music can assist the gathering assembly in preparing for worship in the form of a prelude. It may give voice to the sentiments of the human heart through pieces played during the Liturgy and postludes after the Liturgy. Instrumentalists are encouraged to play pieces from the treasury of sacred music by composers of various eras and cultures."

During times of instrumental music, the congregation isn't to just sit back and wait for the next part of the Mass but rather to use it as a time to reflect on the Word of God and if done during offertory, to actively observe the handing over of bread and wine from the faithful to the priest, who is representing Christ himself, to the altar of sacrifice. In accord with the aforementioned Church documents, more instrumental music is being incorporated into our celebrations at Mt. Carmel from time to time, before and after Mass, and occasionally during the offertory and preparation of the gifts. The titles and composers from these pieces will appear in our Sunday bulletin.

BLESSINGS OF THE THROAT

In Honor of the patron of Throat problems and the Wool trade. St. Blasé was a well educated Physician who became Bishop. He was persecuted by Agricola, the most famous Roman general, who ordered Blasé to renounce his faith. He was thrown into prison when he refused where he helped sick prisoners and famously save a child who was choking on a fish bone. Since his refusal to renounce his faith he was tortured by having his flesh torn with wool combs and finally beheaded on orders of Agricola. So to honor him we will observe the Blessings of the Throat Saturday, January 28 and Sunday, January 29, 2017.

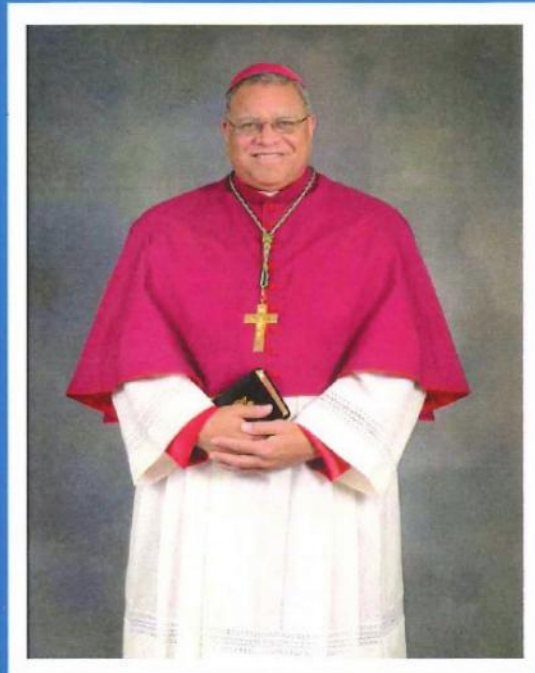
