



Craig's Corner A Note from our Director of Music

Many of the hymns we sing in our Liturgical celebrations have roots from the Reformation, when Martin Luther wanted to give church-goers poetry-like texts sung in their vernacular language. Luther led the way for German chorales that JS Bach and many classical composers would begin composing organ preludes for, in addition to his own melodies. Texts came from metrical psalms, various Scripture passages, texts written to evoke religious emotions, and the goal for these texts and melodies was to empower the congregation into a new connection with worship. Catholic composers and publishers added their own twists in the 1800-1900s, writing hymns based on the Eucharist and in honor of the Virgin Mary. After Vatican II, Catholic churches drew from the many sources of Protestant hymns that had been ongoing for centuries before. The hymn titles are different from hymn tunes. Many tunes with a specific ordered poetic meter, can be adapted to different texts. For example, the hymn tune "Hyfrydol" can be used to the melodies of "Alleluia! Sing to Jesus" and "Love Divine All Loves Excelling." Names of hymn tunes come from people (the composer themselves, or who they dedicate the hymn to), places the hymns were written, historical events, and others. In our missalettes, the hymn tune is often found underneath the hymn's title. The poetic meter is sometimes provided as well. I'll explain this part next week!


