### FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TODAY'S FOCUS:AN "A" ATTITUDE

The Beatitudes in today's Gospel reading show us how to orient ourselves and to give ourselves an attitude toward living that is truly Christ-like.

The first two steps of a twelve step program are to admit both our powerlessness and our need for a power greater than ourselves. For Christians this means we are utterly dependent on god and mutually dependent on each other. The Beatitudes says, Blessed are the poor in spirit (the powerless); those meek enough to let go of our egos, and those who hunger and thirst for a clean heart, Freed from self-focus we can pay attention to those who mourn, hurt and the divisions in our lives. We become compassionate and merciful peacemakers.
