Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting and abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

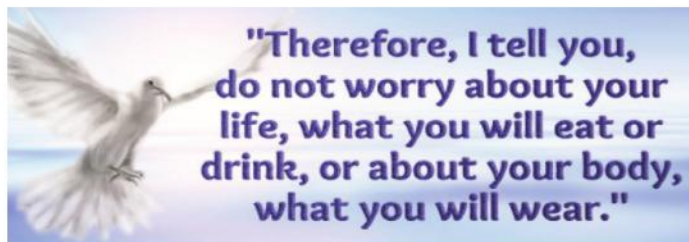

Craig's Corner
A Note from our Director of Music

As we begin Lent on Wednesday, I want to call attention to the role music plays during the season. In Pope Francis' letter for Lent, he reminds us that it is a season of "spiritual renewal" to focus even more on God's Word. The role of music during Lent allows for such additional reflection. In the Lenten season, church documents directly state that the use of the organ "is allowed only in order to support the singing" – so instrumental music or improvisation is restricted to solely prelude and postlude. While the prelude can set the tone for Mass, to foster an even more reflective tone for the Lenten season, no prelude music will be played. With no instrumental music or improvisation before or during Mass, take advantage of this extra silence to let Pope Francis' words echo true – by examining God's Word. Lent is not supposed to be a time of sadness, but a time of prayer and fasting. Organ postludes will therefore echo these themes, and will be prayerful and calm – not utilizing the full sounds which will return for the Easter celebration.

With all of this in mind, I encourage us as a parish to take the opportunity which presents itself over the next 40 days for extra prayer. May the Lenten journey we are about to begin truly be a joyous time, in which we can renew ourselves spiritually and hasten towards the even more joyous celebration of Easter.
