Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meat at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting and abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

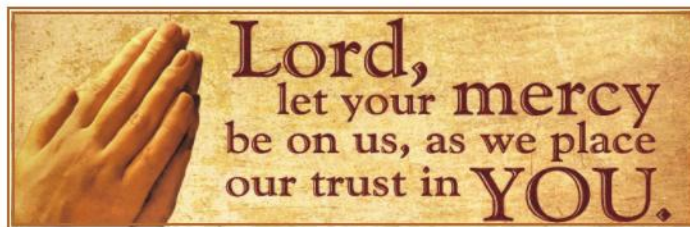

Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

Our Catholic faith brings together many people from many ways of life, incomes, ages, and nationalities. Yet when we walk through the doors of our basilica, or any church, for Sunday Mass, we put those identities aside and converge onto our Catholic identity. When the Second Vatican Council took place in the 1960s, its results shook up the Church. One of the major changes that took place was that the Mass would be prayed in the vernacular language of the people, instead of Latin.

This paved the way for the texts of Mass to be translated into many languages. But in 1974, Pope Paul VI sent a booklet, *Jubilate Deo*, to every bishop of the world; it contained the Gregorian Chant melodies for the propers of the Mass in Latin. The melodies in this booklet are what Pope Paul said was the bare minimum Catholics around the world should know, regardless of which language Mass is being said in.

At Mt. Carmel, we use the traditional Chant VIII melodies from *Jubilate Deo* when we sing the Gloria, Sanctus, and Agnus Dei in Latin. Preserving these chant melodies is still beneficial to the modern Church today. It not only unifies us with the Tradition of the early Church, but creates a bond with the whole world of today, melodies that every Catholic can be unified to in worship.

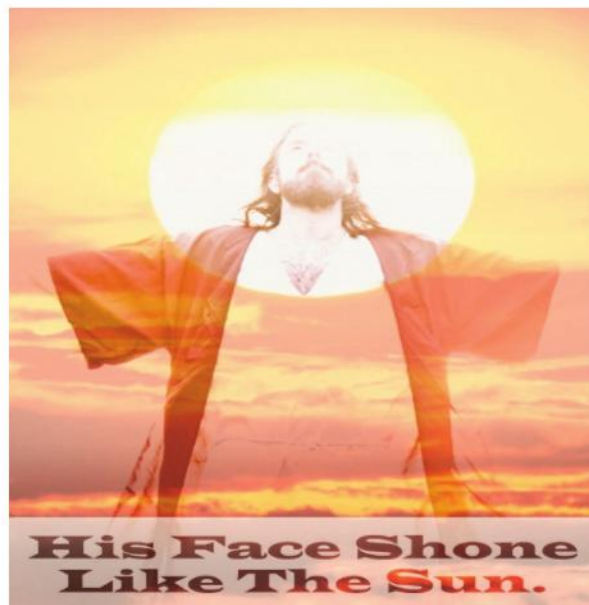

The Diocese of Youngstown will celebrate a special evening of reconciliation entitled "The Light is ON for YOU"

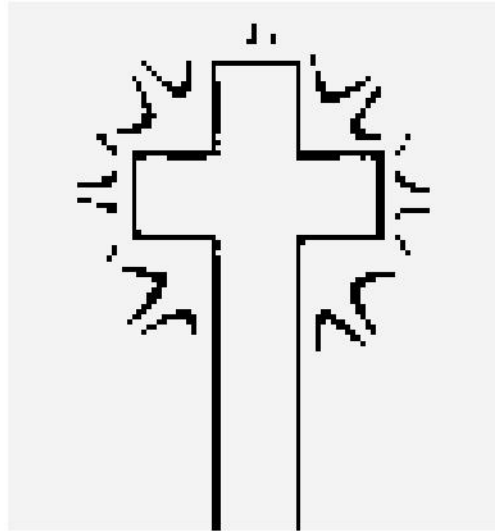
