Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting and abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

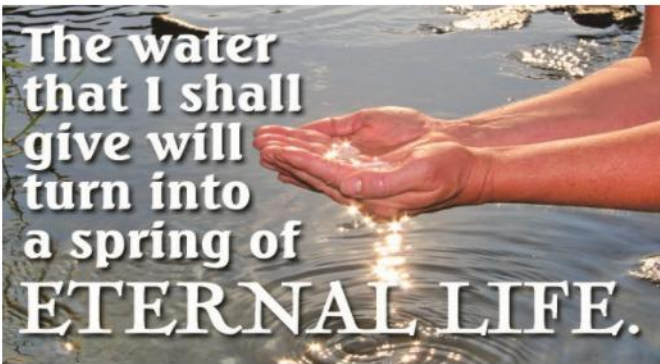

Craig's Corner
A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend's readings primarily focus on the thirst for water. God provided water for the Israelites in the first reading, and Jesus becomes the living water for the Samaritan woman in the Gospel. This is one of three stories we will hear in the Gospels leading up to Passion Sunday, where Jesus has a personal interaction with someone, the others being the story of the man born blind and the story of Lazarus. This weekend, the woman at the well realizes her need for living water – and she receives this through Jesus.

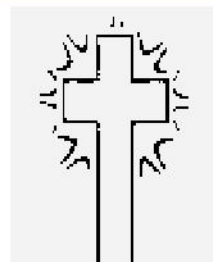
In the Church's directives for those preparing the music for the celebration of the Liturgy, they call to mind three perspectives – one of which is the *Liturgical judgment*. This states that texts sung at Mass support the Liturgical texts of the day and the season. This weekend's offertory hymn, "I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say" personalizes the text of the Gospel by making the story into a prayer; we can call upon Jesus to quench our spiritual soul. We can make the hymn into our personal prayer: "I came to Jesus and I drank of that life-giving stream; My thirst was quenched, my soul revived, and now I live in him." The music at Mass is carefully planned to fit its theme. When we realize this, pick up the Missalettes, and participate in singing, we can praise God in community with those around us, while also using the hymns as another level of reflection for what the readings convey to us. What better time is there to allow these texts to touch us all the more than Lent?
