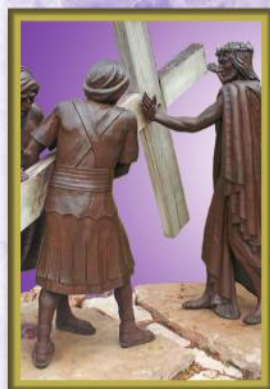


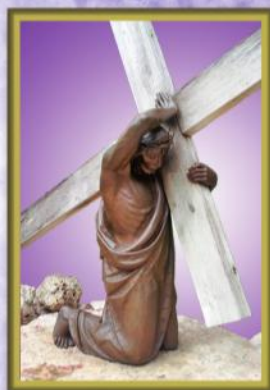

### **THE SEASON OF LENT**

**FASTING:** means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY.

**ABSTINENCE:** are days on which we do not eat any meat at all. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain from meat on ASH WEDNESDAY, GOOD FRIDAY, & ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT.

### **THE FASTING TONGUE**

Lenten penances sometimes appear to focus on what goes into our mouths; but Jesus himself said what comes out of them matters more (Matt 15:11) . That's where the harm is done, to others and to ourselves. And that's what Isaiah calls us to fast from; false accusation and malicious speech.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, the Truth, the Way, and the Life, this Lent may we grow in speaking your truth, following your truth, and living your truth in love.

### FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

#### TODAY'S FOCUS: GOOD AND GOOD FOR YOU

The fruit of the tree in Eden was good, but the eating of it wasn't a good thing for Adam and Eve. In Christ we can discern both what is good and what will be good for us.

The tree was enticing, "good for food, pleasing to the eyes, and desirable for gaining wisdom." Adam and Eve only wanted the good. They ate and their eyes were opened. They were creatures, not gods, nor God. Trying to be something other than who they were filled them with shame. Healthy guilt, on the other hand, means feeling bad about what we did. Shame is destructive. Guilt can give life. We can learn what is truly good, pleasing, and desirable, rather than what only appears to be.
