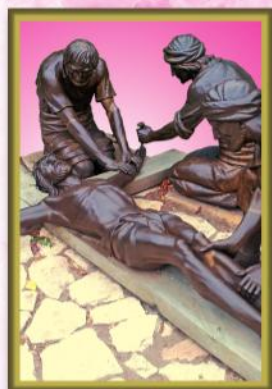




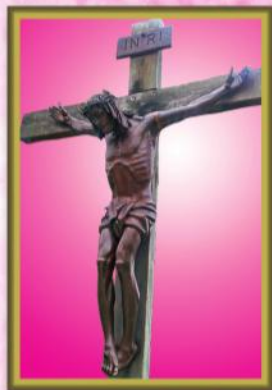

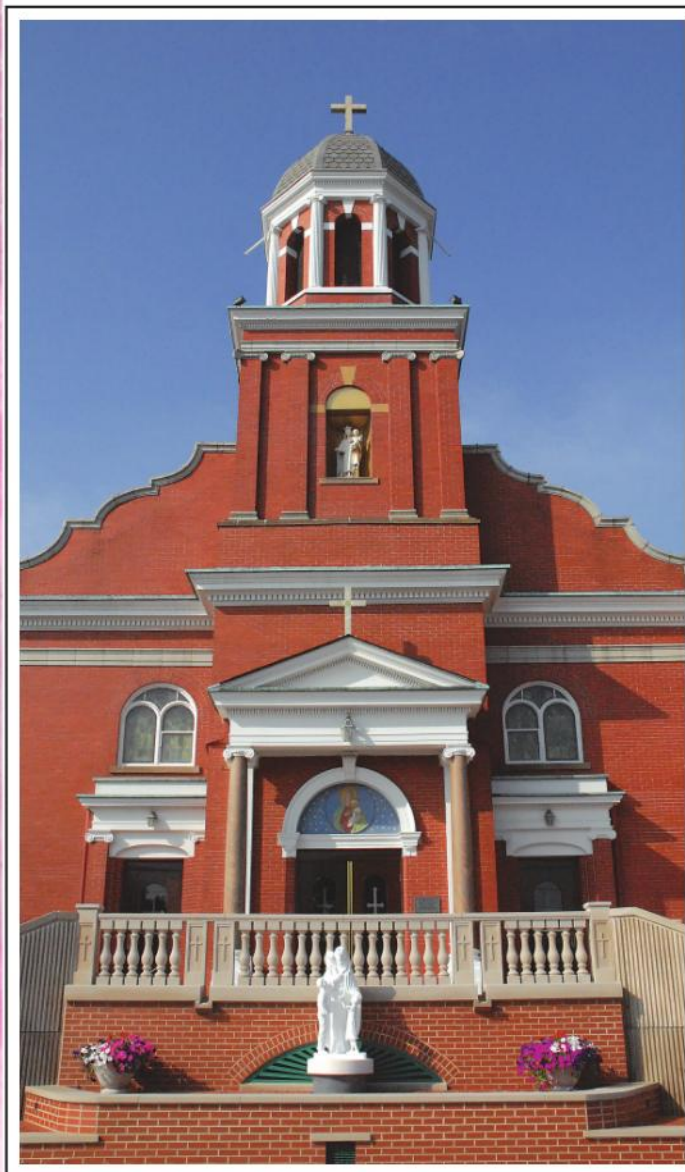

Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting and abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

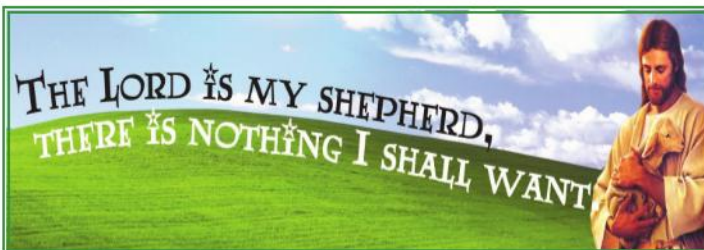

Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

“Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.”

These words, taken from the book from the Prophet Isaiah, are the introit for this Sunday, Laetare Sunday (literally meaning “rejoice”). It is the Sunday of the Lenten season in which the Church calls us to rejoice – our Lenten observance is over halfway complete. Our celebration of the Paschal Mystery and the Easter Sacraments is quickly approaching. This is the Sunday of the Lenten Season with a slightly different tone from the rest of the season. We still don’t sing the Gloria or Alleluia, reminding us it is still a season of penance. However, instrumental music and improvisation are allowed during Mass on this Sunday – as is the decoration of flowers on the altar, and rose colored vestments.

Organ composer Marcel Dupré, when composing his “Stations of the Cross” for organ, came up with a few themes that take place throughout the work. One such theme, the theme of consolation, appears in this weekend’s postlude, *Jesus comforts the women of Jerusalem*. This piece is placed on Laetare Sunday since we are aware that the celebration of saving acts of the cross are near; it is not a reason to be sorrowful, but to feel comfort and rejoicing – because our salvation is at hand.

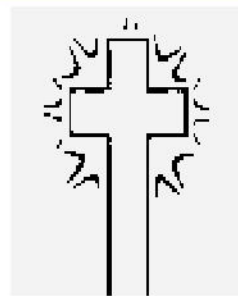
