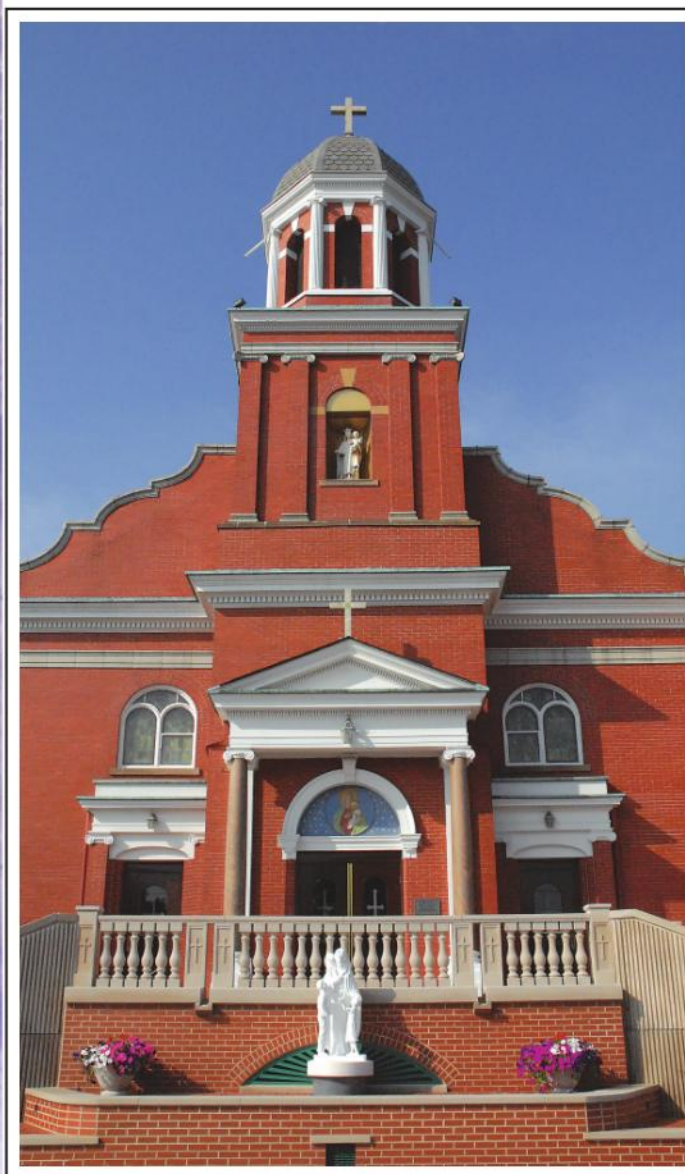

Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting and abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

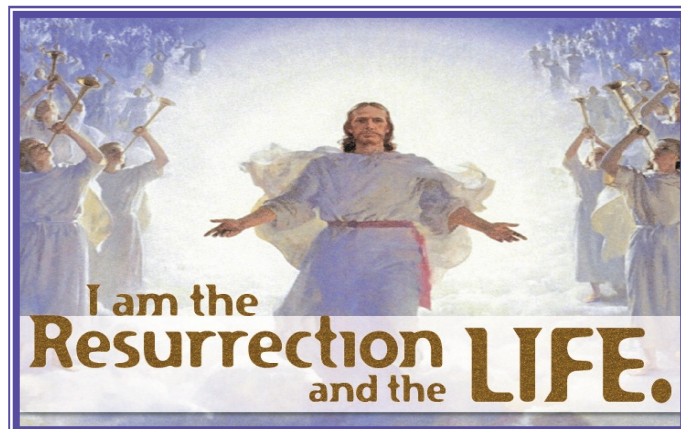

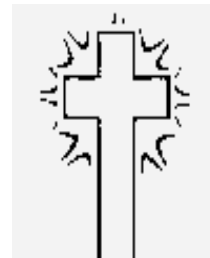


The cross is one of the most common paradoxes of our Catholic faith. What, to many, is a symbol of torture and death, is to us a symbol of new life and resurrection. We know we cannot come to the glory of the resurrection without the pain of the cross. Because of the cross and passion of Jesus, we can receive eternal life. Beginning with this fifth week of the Lenten season, the Church enters what is called *Passiontide*. The Church uses the prayers, readings, and music to focus more on the theme of death and resurrection as we recall the saving acts of the cross which brought salvation to the whole world. This Sunday's readings and music continue to focus on penance and mercy, but add another dimension by adding themes of death and resurrection as we read the account of the raising of Jesus' friend Lazarus.

As I have stated in previous weeks, the Church calls on music ministers to continue to foster the use of Gregorian Chant in the Mass in our modern time. At a funeral Mass, this is no different as it is a tradition at Our Lady of Mount Carmel to chant the *In Paradisum* chant during the procession from the basilica to the cemetery. The text, which begins with "may the angels lead you into paradise," is meant to be a consoling text of release into the eternal kingdom, and not a text of torment and sadness. To non-believers, a funeral is the end of life; we as Catholics know that this is not the end, rather a new beginning, just like the cross. This weekend's postlude is an arrangement of this *In Paradisum* chant.
