

OUR LADY OF MT. CARMEL BASILICA YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO



I've always loved Palm Sunday Mass because the Church presents two themes in one celebration. Mass begins regally, with palm branches to welcome Jesus triumphantly into Jerusalem. However, following the hymn "All Glory Laud and Honor," the opening prayer signals a moment of change. We are reminded that Jesus' entry into Jerusalem was only the start of the journey – the purpose of this trip to Jerusalem was for our salvation, to "submit to the Cross." The remainder of the Mass focuses on the Passion and suffering of the Cross.

Just as the prayers and readings of the day show both triumph and sorrow, so does the music. The hosannas and trumpets of the opening of the Mass and procession transform to the crying out of "My God, My God, why have you abandoned me?" and "Lord, let me walk that lonely road with you." This weekend's postlude, the Adagio in G Minor, presents melodies and chords of sadness and pain. As we go through this Holy Week, together with our Catholic brothers and sisters, receive Jesus' body and blood and commandment of love on Holy Thursday, walk the road of the cross on Good Friday, and await new life and Resurrection at the tomb on Holy Saturday. Our Lenten journey of penance culminates in the celebration of the Paschal Mystery this Holy Week. May we, as parishioners of this basilica, who enter the church with hosannas today, use the music, readings and prayers of the rest of this week's celebrations to feel the pain and suffering of the cross, so that we may come to fully share in the festival of Easter next week.
