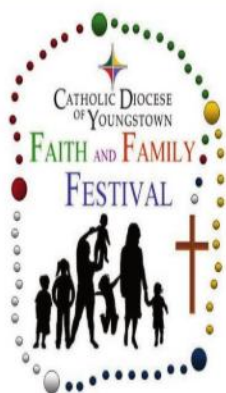

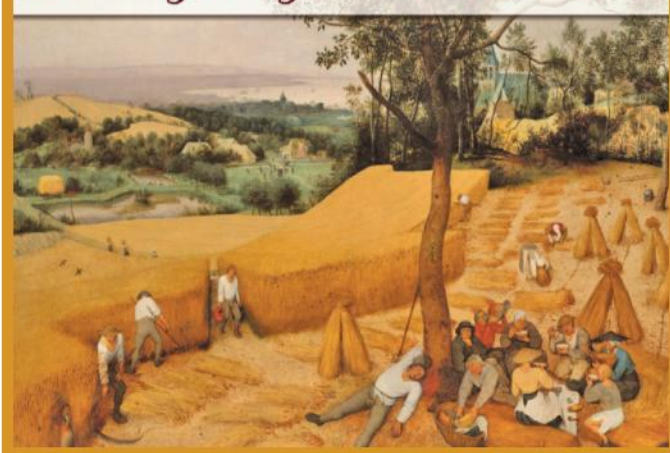

A Note from our Director of Music

Our summer of parables continues as we hear the narrative of the harvest and weeds in today's Gospel. Jesus tells us not to bother the weeds until the harvest, so that the weeds can be separated from the wheat: symbolizing the kingdom. The first and second readings, as well as the Responsorial Psalm point us towards this kingdom. Though we have weaknesses, our master who though is our judge, is also good and forgiving, giving us the Spirit to aid us in our trials.

The choice of the music this weekend is twofold, both to echo these sentiments from the Scriptures presented to us and to greet our parishioners and guests in celebration as many of us attend our parish festival. The kingdom foreshadowed by the Gospel parable is represented in our opening hymn as we proclaim Jesus as our sovereign King. In that kingdom too is Mary, our queen. Since our parish is dedicated to her, and especially during this year of Mary, our offertory hymn praises her in a special way. Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the **Catechism of the Catholic Church**:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the faithful.

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.

On the above days, I plan to announce these special days in advance so that the Faithful may mark their calendar. God's choicest blessing upon you in this Special Year of Mary, May 17, 2017-May 13, 2018 the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.
