

"And for generation upon generation is His mercy, to those who fear Him" (Luke 1:50).





## <u>Craig's Corner</u> A Note from our Director of Music

Last weekend at our parish festival, I had a conversation with some parishioners about the songs for communion. For our Feast Day weekend, we sang "As I Kneel Before You", a beloved hymn in honor of our Blessed Mother. I was asked why we do not often sing Marian hymns for communion unless it is a Marian feast day. While in this year of Mary, we have been and will continue to sing many Marian hymns at Mass, the reason they often fall outside of Communion is given in the Liturgical directives.

The directives state: "In selecting a Communion song suitable for the Eucharistic banquet in which God's blessings are bestowed so abundantly, one should look for texts that have themes of joy, wonder, unity, gratitude, and praise. Following ancient Roman liturgical tradition, the Communion song might reflect themes of the Gospel reading of the day. It is also appropriate to select a Communion processional song that reflects the liturgical action, i.e., eating and drinking the Body and Blood of Christ."

This weekend, as we continue to hear the parables of Jesus speaking to us of the kingdom, we will praise Mary as our mother at the offertory, with "Sing of Mary". This hymn reflects on Mary's role in our tradition: being the mother of our Savior who came forth from her side to preach these parables to us, the mother in pain at the foot of the cross, and the mother robed in splendor in the heavens. To go along with the aforementioned Communion Rite directives, the hymn during the Communion procession this weekend, "Blest are They", reflects the kingdom of God portrayed in the Gospel; it also speaks of the nourishment we receive at the altar, for those of us who hunger and thirst for God will have our fill at the Eucharistic table.

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the faithful.

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.

On the above days, I plan to announce these special days in advance so that the Faithful may mark their calendar. God's choicest blessing upon you in this Special Year of Mary, May 17, 2017-May 13, 2018 the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.
