

<u>Craig's corner</u> **A Note from our Director of Music**

Our Christmas season continues this weekend as we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. I often find humor in the reaction I get from some of my friends who are not as well versed in the Liturgical Year when they hear that I'm still playing Christmas music for a few weeks after actual Christmas day. I always find it interesting that the radio stations that start Christmas music what seems like months ahead of Christmas, go back to their regular brand as soon as the clock strikes midnight on December 26.

The Church celebrates Christmas day as an octave: eight days of celebrating Christmas day. This feast of the Holy Family falls on the Sunday in the octave of Christmas. The octave concludes with the celebration of Mary as the Mother of God on January 1. But the Christmas season doesn't end there. We still celebrate Epiphany and the Baptism of the Lord. This year, because Epiphany is celebrated later than usual, the Baptism falls on a Monday instead of the Sunday after Epiphany.

So even though the radio stations don't play the Christmas music any more, let us enjoy our Liturgical celebration of Christmas this weekend and continuing through January 8. We will still be singing Christmas hymns and carols praising our newborn King. The prelude and postlude this weekend are two different Baroque settings of the Christmas hymn "Good Christian Friends, Rejoice," hymn tune *In dulci jubilo*. The text of the hymn is set to a folk melody, which relates back to the medieval period; during this period, hymns were in Latin, setting them to familiar tunes would allow them to sing them easier.




