FAST from worry; FEAST on divine-order. Thrust in God. **FAST** from complaining; **FEAST** on appreciation. **FAST from bitterness**; FEAST on forgiveness. **FAST** from self-concern; FEAST on compassion for others. FAST from discouragement: FEAST on hope.
