**Lent has traditionally been a time for fasting.  
In a culture of excessive consumption that dulls  
The promptings of God's Spirit within us,  
Lent can help us slow down and focus our attention

**Lent should be more than a time for fasting.  
It should also be a joyous season of feasting.  
Lent is a time to FAST FROM certain things  
And to FEAST ON others.  
It is a season in which you can creatively explore how  
to:**

**FAST from judging others;  
FEAST on the Christ within them.  
FAST from emphasis on differences;  
FEAST on the unity of life.  
FAST from thought of illness;  
FEAST on the healing power of God.  
FAST from discontent;  
FEAST on gratitude.  
FAST from anger;  
FEAST on patience.  
FAST from pessimism;  
FEAST on optimism.  
FAST from worry;  
FEAST on divine-order. Thrust in God.  
FAST from complaining;  
FEAST on appreciation.  
FAST from bitterness;  
FEAST on forgiveness.  
FAST from self-concern;  
FEAST on compassion for others.  
FAST from discouragement;  
FEAST on hope.**
