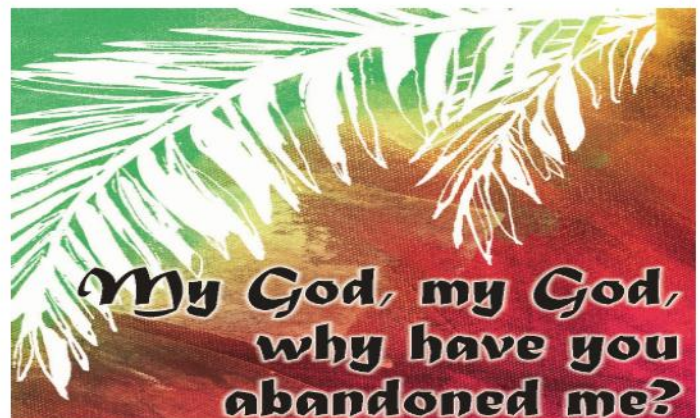

**ANNUNCIATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

Feast: March 25

AT THE Annunciation, God proposes the mystery of the Incarnation which will be fulfilled in the Blessed Virgin when she shall have given her free consent. It is as if God awaited the response of the humanity to which He wills to unite Himself. Full of faith, Mary gives her reply: “Behold the handmaid of the Lord, be it done to me according to Thy word.” At this moment the Divine Word, The Second Person of the Holy Trinity, becomes incarnate in Mary. It is the greatest event in history. This mystery has earned for Mary the most glorious of her titles, that of Mother of God, which makes her all-powerful with her Son. Have recourse to her intercession with Him, and at the same time rejoice in the honor which is yours—the honor of being able to call the Mother of God your own Mother.

“Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women.” (Luke 1, 28).





**Craig's corner**

**A Note from our Director of Music**

Do you wonder if Barabbas ever truly realized how significant he was? He was the first person to be freed by Jesus' sacrifice. Jesus took his place on the cross, and thus was able to finish His mission to save not just Barabbas, but us as well. We really are not that different from Barabbas, are we? I hope we are not murderers or thieves, but we *are* sinners. St. Paul says "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23). Because of our sins, we die to earth. But because Jesus took Barabbas' place and in turn, our place, on the cross, we have the gift of eternal life. The first time I really thought this through, it genuinely opened my eyes to what we celebrate this Holy Week.

I remember when the movie, *The Passion of the Christ*, came out back in 2004, I was 14 years old. I had been in Catholic school for my entire life and knew the chronology of the events that made up the final hours of Jesus' life. But seeing just how graphic the movie was, many people were skeptical to bring young adults or kids to see this because it was "scary" or "gory." Sometimes it takes something **big** to alter our way of thinking. After all, we celebrate Holy Week every year, so what makes it different than just "any other Palm Sunday?" It can be something as graphic as watching *The Passion of the Christ*, but, as I have alluded to before, sometimes music with or without text can evoke emotion in us that words cannot.

Palm Sunday's texts and music offer two contradictory emotions. We begin Mass in joy with a trumpet fanfare welcoming Jesus into Jerusalem with palm branches. Then, in the blink of an eye, the tone changes. This year, we have been celebrating the Year of Mary. Monsignor has preached a few times this Lent of how we can look at the model of the Sorrowful Mother. Our offertory hymn takes into account her sorrow as she has to see her son beaten with whips, bruised, mocked, bleeding from the crown of thorns, crucified, and die right before her eyes. The hymn "Stabat Mater," or known in English "At the Cross Her Station Keeping," is one of the saddest texts ever written, as it puts us in the vision of Mary, seeing her Son die excruciatingly on the cross. During Communion, we take these emotions upon ourselves as we pray that though the cross is a symbol of torture and pain, it is also a symbol of gladness on which our hope is hung. The anthem this weekend, "Lenten Litany" combines the sorrow of the final hours of Jesus' life with the prayer that God hears our prayers of repentance we have been praying this Lenten season, so that we may be freed from suffering in the kingdom of heaven.

The tune of the "Stabat Mater" comes in the final section of this weekend's postlude, Marcel Dupré's "Crucifixion." Talk about emotion! This organ symphony is a dramatic instrumental piece depicting Jesus' final moments on earth. There are very few musical melodies in the piece but they grow in development through the work as the organ climbs in volume. The piece depicts Jesus' walk to Calvary in a very dark and sinister accompaniment culminating in loud, dramatic, screaming chords, depicting the driving of the nails into each of Jesus' wrists and then His two feet; it then sharply diminishes as Jesus dies, with only the "Stabat Mater" remaining as Mary watches on in deep sorrow.

I pray that the music this Palm Sunday and Holy Week ahead allows you to come to deeper prayer than ever and that we do not just "go through the motions" this week, but realize what it is we celebrate: we have been saved because Jesus took Barabbas' place. Jesus was the one who had to suffer so much, so that we could live with Him forever. Mary, our Sorrowful Mother, *pray for us.*

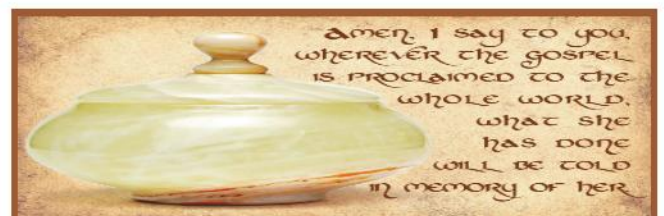
