





<u>Craig's Corner</u> A Note from our Director of Music

While we know the Easter Season lasts fifty days, it is often overlooked that the Easter Day celebration in the Church lasts for eight days; this is known of as the octave of Easter. The Sunday within this octave, the second Sunday of Easter, was proclaimed to be Divine Mercy Sunday by Pope John Paul II in 2000. The chaplet of Divine Mercy, which begins on Good Friday, draws attention to how through the saving acts of Jesus' death and resurrection, God showed His mercy for His people. Our previous music director at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Mark Izzo, wrote the Canticle of Divine Mercy from the text of the chaplet, which is being used during the offertory procession this weekend. To show cohesion between this and last Sunday, the instrumental pieces at this weekend's Masses bring back many melodies from Easter weekend. The prelude, with the melody of the chorale "Christ Lag in Todesbanden" is also part of the text of the Easter Sunday sequence, Victimae Paschali Laudes - Christians Praise the Paschal Victim. Last weekend, we opened our Mass with the alleluias of the beloved Easter hymn, "Jesus Christ is Risen Today." This weekend, to close our Easter octave, we again sing this hymn. The postlude, Charles Villiers Stanford's At Easter-Tide presents fragments of the alleluia in the hymn at the beginning of the piece, passing from the bass voice at the opening to the soprano voice. The middle section begins softly, but rises, symbolic of the resurrection, culminating with the full statement of the alleluia heard in the bass. Then as the overlying chords continue to build to the climax, a brief pause comes before the finale where the entire alleluia is heard in the soprano voice to end the piece.

May the full joy of Easter continue in all of us, not just for the Sunday of Easter and this octave, but the remainder of these entire fifty days.

Classes are scheduled every other month on the first two Mondays of the month. Next class will be May 7 & 14



For Families with Special Needs


Information and referral services for families of children with special needs.
