**THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER
TODAY’S FOCUS: OPEN MINDS, HEARTS AFLAME**

The disciples’ response in the familiar Emmaus story should be our own, especially when we celebrate the Eucharist-to have our minds open to God’s word, to have our hearts on fire for Christ.

John emphasizes that a person’s relationship with God results from believing the “Truth” about Jesus and living according to that “Truth.”. Luke emphasizes that Jesus is the fulfillment of the scriptural promises. Jesus opened the minds of his disciples to understand the scriptures so that they could preach His name to the “nations”.
