





Craig's Corner A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend we celebrate the image of Christ as our Shepherd. The most common psalm I do at funerals is Psalm 23, "The Lord is my Shepherd." It speaks of comfort as we hear Jesus tell us in the gospel this weekend that He has come to lay down His life and take it up again so that we can rest beside his peaceful waters when our earthly pilgrimage ends. When I accompany the psalm on the organ I often keep the sound as a calm and peaceful accompaniment until verse 4 where it becomes brighter. At this point, the text turns to the heavenly kingdom: "And I shall dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life." This brighter tone echoes an Easter theme of darkness to light, of death to resurrection, to our heavenly goal. A paraphrase of this psalm is the text of the offertory hymn this weekend: "The King of Love."

Now that we have celebrated His passion, death and in the past three Sundays have heard three accounts of Jesus' resurrection and appearances to the disciples, we continue the Easter season as we will begin to prepare for Jesus' commission to us to continue His message after His ascension, filled with the Holy Spirit which we will celebrate on Pentecost. Let the words of our hymns and prayers this weekend refresh us, as if by God's restful waters; we should not worry about the valley of darkness, for our Shepherd is with us. This idea was also the inspiration behind today's prelude, "Sheep May Safely Graze," that we may *safely graze and pasture in a watchful shepherd's sight.*

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.


The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
