





# Craig's Corner A Note from our Director of Music

On Palm Sunday, I discussed the lamentations of the Blessed Virgin Mary most vividly through the text of the Stabat Mater, "At the Cross Her Station Keeping." Mary had to watch her Son be beaten, tortured, crucified, and die right before her eyes. Then with Easter Sunday and in subsequent weekends of the Easter Season, Jesus appeared to His mother and the disciples in His glorified state. The angel appeared to Jesus' closest apostles and to Mary, telling her that her Son was indeed raised from the dead and her grief was changed into joy!

As we come to the close of our Year of Mary in a couple weeks, I wanted to highlight the Blessed Virgin Mary with a couple of Marian hymns this weekend. Firstly, the prelude is an arrangement of a Marian text and melody which is used in the Orthodox Church. This text revolves around the angel appearing to Mary and the others at the tomb on that Easter morning, saying, "The angel cried to her who was filled with grace, exclaiming: 'Rejoice, O purest Virgin, again, rejoice, I tell you, because your Son is risen from three days of entombment." Our opening hymn, "Be Joyful Mary, Heavenly Queen," is this text expanded. It is the fulfillment of the "At the Cross Her Station Keeping" text — Mary's grief was changed to joy serene, for the Lord has risen from the dead as He had said He would!

The readings of the middle of the Easter Season now begin to turn from the resurrection itself to our call as Christians to spread this account! The resurrected Christ left the Church to us; however, before He ascended to the Father, He reminds us of the commandments of love and service to one another. As the Acts of the Apostles tells us, the disciples had a tough time proclaiming the message to the early Church. Even though many tried to kill them, the Holy Spirit allowed the Church to grow in number. Our offertory hymn this weekend, "We Have Been Told," blends all of these themes together. We have seen the face of God through His teachings and His love poured out on the cross; now we have to bring that message of love into the world. In this hymn, our communion hymn "I Received the Living God," and in the Gospel today, it is stated that Christ is the vine and we are the branches. We have to bear the fruit now to keep the Church alive! As we move forward in our Easter journey, let us keep the joy of the Blessed Virgin Mary in our hearts as we proclaim the Risen Christ to everyone.

#### From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church</u>: An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.


