#### A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend, as we celebrate the sixth Sunday in the Easter Season, we come to our final Sunday before the celebration of the Ascension. The Gospel we hear this weekend did not come just before the Ascension, but rather, it was one of the final addresses He made to the disciples before His passion and death.

It is fitting that one of His last messages to the disciples is a message of love. We hear this theme of the commandment of love in both St. Paul's words in today's second reading as well in the Gospel where Jesus commissions the disciples to carry on His message and example of true love: to lay down one's life for one's friends. The first reading speaks of how the Holy Spirit enabled the apostles to carry out this mission after Jesus' ascension, and we know that later most of the apostles suffered martyrdom because of the faith.

Our music this weekend focuses almost entirely on Jesus' commandment of love. We conclude Mass in this Year of Mary and begin the month of May with celebrating again the joy of the Blessed Virgin Mary proclaiming the Risen Christ! And to remind us of our Easter renewal of the promises we made to Christ's Church, our entrance rites are accompanied with the blessing and sprinkling of the holy water.

To conclude this week, I want to share a brief letter written by Christine Langer, who as you all have gotten to know, and as Monsignor mentioned last weekend, was our voice and piano intern for the spring semester as part of the diocese's Cecilia Project to train high school or college aged students for music ministry. Christine is back at her home parish in North Canton now for the summer. Christine writes all of the following to you all, our Parish community:

"I would like to take this opportunity to thank Msgr. Cariglio for allowing me to intern and volunteer my time here at OLMC. I would also like to thank the choir for welcoming me as a fellow choir member this semester. Finally, I thank your music director, Craig, who has been my mentor throughout this experience. In addition to working with me in liturgical music, showing me how to tune the organ, and guiding me in music planning, he also introduced me to other aspects of life at this parish, such as coffee and donut Sundays and the wonderful spaghetti dinners (where we were typically joined by the sacristans, who have also become great friends: thanks Dan, Dom, and Phillip!). # From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.


