

Craig's Corner A Note from our Director of Music

Often times it is difficult to grasp new concepts or hear new ideas. The same holds true in music; new music can often take time to understand and appreciate. Many twentieth century composers used new musical concepts and imagery to write various works. Olivier Messiaen, a Catholic composer from this time period, falls in this category with his "symphonic meditations" titled *L'Ascension* (Ascension Day) written in 1932-33 for orchestra, but also for organ. The first movement is part of our 5pm, 8am, and Noon Masses this weekend for prelude.

The title, Prayer of Christ Ascending towards His Father, is inspired by the text: "And now, O Father, I have manifested Thy name unto men....and now, I am no more in the world, but these are in the world and I come to Thee." The piece, which is the conclusion of the entire work, was composed to be eternal; with no real end or beginning, but rather simply ascending. It reaches its highest point at its conclusion, then in a sense, vanishes from sight. It ends without resolution, much like the ascension of the Lord. Jesus has left us on this earth, ascending to the Father, while we are commissioned to promote his teachings and way of life.


I know most of you will read this after hearing these pieces this weekend, but I write this so that we see there is a "method to my *madness*." These type of pieces can truly broaden ones theological and musical mind. The music we hear at Mass doesn't always have to entertain us, but rather it should allow us to transcend to the heavens, hopefully giving us a greater appreciation of our faith. Let us use music and the prayers of our Ascension Mass this weekend to bring us to another dimension — to allow us to ascend to heavenly thoughts as we celebrate Jesus' ascent to the Father, to prepare for us the place we hope to attain after we depart this world.

As we close our Year of Mary this weekend, after the conclusion of our Ascension Mass, we crown our Blessed Mother. Following our Marian hymn, the postlude is a verse from Jean-Adam Gulian's *Magnificat*, or Mary's song of Praise in the Gospel of Luke – "The Almighty has done great things for me and holy is His name." French classical organ composers often composed music that was a unique blend of showcasing the different sounds of the organ while preserving ancient chants. The entire piece is composed of verses, when performed in its entirety, alternates between organ and choir. The central verse, the Basse de Trompette is the postlude this weekend.

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ.

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
