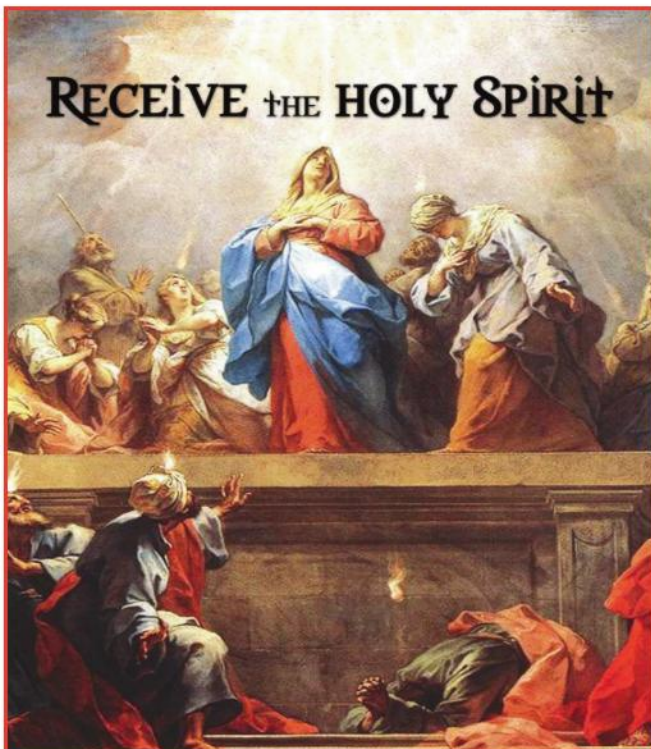

Craig's Corner
A Note from our Director of Music

As Catholics, we are no strangers to Gregorian Chant. These melodies, sung practically since the beginning of the Church, are a unique sentiment to our faith. One way these chant melodies were sung in Church history was that of the Chant Mass versets. This was a common practice in the French Baroque period of the 1600-1700s. One verse would be sung by the choir, followed by an organ verse with not necessarily the same melody (although often the melody is hidden in the first organ verse) typically highlighting the different sounds of the instrument. The chant melody, "Veni Creator Spiritus," the text of the Pentecost Sequence, and its subsequent verses composed by Nicolas de Grigny in 1699 are used as the offertory and postlude for our Pentecost Masses. The chant itself is heard and improvised on in the prelude this weekend.

With this feast we celebrate the end of our fifty days of Easter. It is my hope that the music and our celebrations of Lent, the Triduum, and Easter have brought you to a deeper faith in Christ. While Easter ends, our mission only begins. This is the same mission that the disciples proclaimed after receiving power from the Holy Spirit – the Spirit we celebrate today. Today's feast is considered the birthday of the Church. Without the Spirit, the apostles could not proclaim all that they had just witnessed.

With renewed faith after our Easter journey, we too must proclaim through our singing, our words, and our actions. The congregational hymns this weekend of course also center on our mission and the Holy Spirit. We invoke the Holy Ghost during our opening procession, sing the psalm of the Spirit at Communion, and as we are sent forth at the recessional, ask the breath and gifts of the Spirit to enter us. Let me conclude with the third verse of our closing hymn. The verse prays, "to us your varied gifts make known, teach us to speak, teach us to hear." All we have celebrated since the coming of Christ on Christmas is culminated this weekend as the gifts of the Holy Spirit come upon us. As our Liturgical Year continues on, we will praise the Trinity and celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ then enjoy the rest of Ordinary Time, hearing the teachings of Christ and of His miracles. As we go forward, let us sing our praise to God, as we carry on His mission renewed by the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the **Catechism of the Catholic Church**: An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
