

# THE MOST HOLY TRINITY



A familiar text to many priests, deacons, and religious is that of the *Te Deum*. Many scholars agree that the text of this hymn goes back to Nicetas, Bishop of Remesiana / Romatiana in what is now Servia, born around 335 and died in about 414. It is sung or recited often at the end of the Liturgy of the Hours most Sundays and feasts of the year outside of Advent, Lent, and Holy Week. It is also used for days of special blessing, such as the election of a Pope. Most Christians would recognize the English metrical translation to be that of the hymn, "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name" or "You are God, We Praise You." The text fits that of many hymns which contain the doxology, and has sections in it devoted to God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit which we celebrate this weekend.

Jean Langlais was a Twentieth Century composer who often took these old Gregorian Chant melodies and made them very new in his organ and choral works. Jean concluded his Three Gregorian Paraphrases composition with the *Te Deum*, which is the postlude this weekend.

Another chant melody used to honor the Trinity is *Ave colenda Trinitas*, which is the text of our opening hymn this weekend, "All Hail, Adored Trinity." This hymn is set to the Old Hundredth hymn tune which we are all familiar with. English composer Henry Purcell wrote an organ voluntary based on this hymn melody, which is used as our prelude on this Trinity weekend.

"Glory be to the Father, to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end, amen." This prayer, the Glory be or Gloria Patri, has been part of Christianity since its beginnings, as St. Paul often praises the Trinity in these or similar words in many of his writings. The term for this praise of God is doxology. While we pray these words when reciting the rosary and at other times in prayer, adaptations of this doxology are found in many hymns and psalms as a final verse. One of many examples is our offertory hymn this weekend, Come, Our Almighty King: verse 1 praises God as Father, verse 2 praises Jesus the incarnate Word, verse 3 praises the Spirit as comforter, and verse 4 is the doxology, praising the One in Three, the eternal Trinity forevermore. While this weekend's solemnity of the Trinity calls special attention to the Triune God, we praise the Trinity each time we pray and begin our Masses. Can you think of other hymns (there are many) whose final verse serves as a doxology?

# From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.




