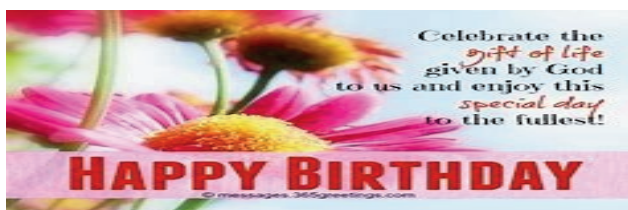
**FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER
