

ASCENSION OF THE LORD TODAY'S FOCUS: UNEXPECTED PLACES

Extraordinary events were clear, if at first unexpected, ways that God's reign came to the world. We can bring God's presence in daily living, so God's reign still comes in unexpected ways.

Both the Gospel of Luke and Acts of the Apostles depict the ascension of the Lord. Jesus blesses the disciples and is then taken up into heaven. Ephesians provides directions for believers who wondered how to live in the in-between Jesus' ascension and his eventual return. First, live an exemplary life of virtue that exhibits humility, gentleness, patience and peace. Second, enliven the grace we have been given for the service and well-being of the community.
