

Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

After our Lenten and Easter seasons, the church returns to our ordered weeks of the Church year labeled Ordinary Time. For the past two weekends, our solemnities of Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi Sunday overshadowed the ordinal Sunday, but this weekend we return to seeing the Church in its color of green as we walk through the remainder of the Church year, following the teachings and miracles of Christ and applying His words to our daily lives.

Our readings this weekend begin with the familiar account of original sin in Genesis, echoed in the Psalm and our Gospel this weekend which references and proclaims the forgiveness of sins through the Holy Spirit and the strong mercy of God in Jesus Christ. People were calling Him possessed; rather, it was the Holy Spirit which drives out the demons through Christ. Jesus ends the Gospel this weekend with the command to do the will of God the Father, and we will be His brothers and sisters. Our closing hymn this weekend echoes this, as "Let there be Peace on Earth" proclaims "with God as our Father, brothers all are we. Let me walk with my brother in perfect harmony." Saint Francis, in his familiar text, prays that we become instruments of peace, not possessed by Satan, but in the midst of hate to bring love and in the midst of sadness to bring joy.

As we begin our celebration this week, we sing "On this Day the First of Days," a hymn which sums up our faith; it proclaims God the Father as Creator, God the Son who triumphed over death, and the Spirit who departs his gifts of fire. The hymn also acclaims that it is Jesus who sets us free from sin. As the Psalm declares, "With the Lord there is mercy, and fullness of redemption," while the second reading acclaims that our inner self is being renewed through this grace. Though we have completed our major seasons of the year, Ordinary Time is not just a time to sit back and let time pass by. Let the readings, the prayers, and the music of the season each weekend renew us as we order our weeks according to the teachings of Christ!

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.


