Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

As we approach the summer solstice this Thursday, June 21, there is one thing most of us, if not all of us, seek on a hot summer day: areas of shade. Christ references this shade in this weekend's Gospel as He teaches the disciples about the kingdom of God. He tells us that even though a mustard seed is a small seed, it will grow into one of the largest plants, so large that birds seek to dwell in its shade. We as His people are so small in the history of creation, but if we are sown with the gift of faith which St. Paul speaks of in the second reading, we will live in that kingdom forever.

Christ often comments on themes of nature when describing His Father's kingdom. We see that this weekend with the parable of the mustard seed, and with His referencing of the birds basking in shade. The first reading from the prophet Ezekiel brings out many more images of nature, foreshadowing Jesus' parable in the Gospel.

Typically appearing around Christmastime with themes of shepherds at the manger, a pastorella is a pastoral style work of music which evokes the countryside. It often is composed of a droning bass and/or simple melodies that move in peaceful, ear-appealing thirds. This weekend's many images of nature in the readings make Bach's short pastorella, titled "Pastorella," an appropriate prelude for this weekend's Masses. The hymn of the day, used in part for opening and closing this weekend, "Joyful, Joyful, We Adore Thee" also evokes imagery of birds, nature, and we as His people, to come to our celebration this weekend in praise of God. The postlude is a common adaptation of this hymn.

Not surprisingly, the Psalm this weekend speaks of nature as well: the cedar tree and plants flourishing and providing fruit, if they are planted in God's courts. The psalm acclaims these things are worthy of us giving thanks to God. Our offertory hymn, "Ti Ringrazio, O Mio Signore" ("I Give Thanks to You, O my God"), takes this theme of thanksgiving and combines it with our Italian heritage. The entire weekend is summed up through our communion hymn, "Taste and See," as we come to our Eucharistic table this day, at which we can taste and see the Lord's goodness, bless the Lord at all times with praise on our lips, and grow in faith.

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the **Catechism of the Catholic Church**: An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

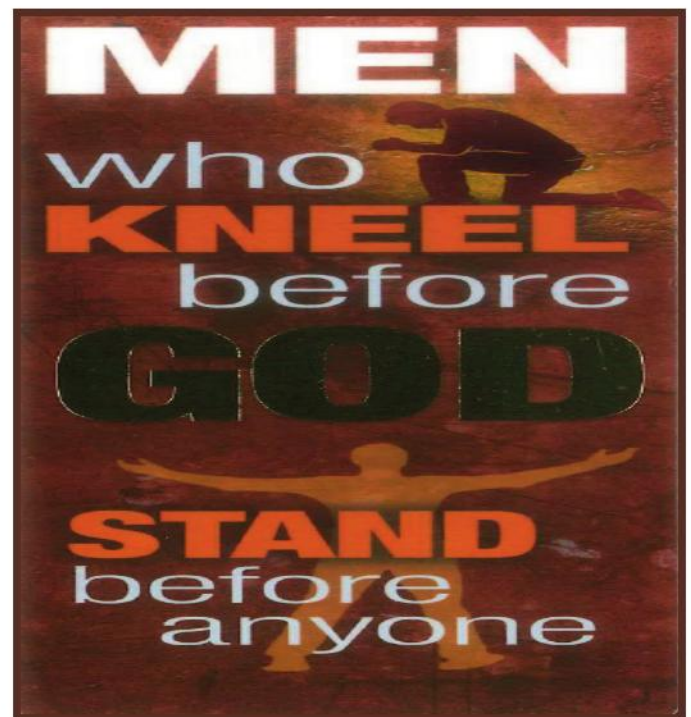
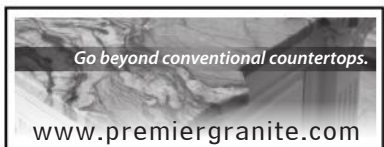
Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
