



A Note from our Director of Music

This year, we get the privilege of celebrating the solemnity of St. John the Baptist's birth on a Sunday! Since this is a solemnity, is preempts the ordinary Sunday Mass. The melody of this weekend's prelude comes from an ancient Gregorian melody written specifically for this solemnity. The text comes from an Eighth Century Benedictine monk living in the Lombardy region of Italy for most of his life: Paul the Deacon. Two of its thirteen verses are as follows:

Lo! A swift herald, from the skies descending, Bears to thy father promise of thy greatness; How he shall name thee, what thy future story, Duly revealing.

O More than blessed, merit high attaining, Pure as the snow-drift, innocent of evil, Child of the desert, mightiest of martyrs, Greatest of prophets.

I chose these two verses because they correspond the most with this weekend's music. The first quotation above summarizes our entrance antiphons, both the Vigil Mass and Day Masses, which introduce us to the scripture in the readings to come: that it was John who was chosen to eventually reveal the coming Savior. Our offertory hymn, "Faith of our Fathers" speaks of our martyred forefathers; this is noted in the second stanza quoted above. John was beheaded after his ministry. That is echoed in our communion hymn, "Blest are They" which reminds us that we are blessed if we suffer hatred for the sake of Christ, just as John eventually did. Our closing hymn, the common "For all the Saints" closes our solemnity this weekend and sings of all the saints that have gone before us. Now we must model our lives to theirs, being strong in our faith by the baptism John preached, and we received, as we go about and proclaim the kingdom which John, the "greatest of prophets" first foreshadowed.

Dear Friends in Christ.

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic</u> <u>Church:</u>

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
