



A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend's readings present fundamental truths of religious beliefs. We begin by hearing how it was not God who brought sin, disease, and death into the world; rather, the devil is responsible. This is echoed in the Gospel as we hear of accounts of Jesus' healings of a few sick and near-death members of the crowd where He was. He tells them not to fear and have faith in Him. The second reading reminds us that this is one of Christ's reasons for coming to this earth; He became poor to show us the richness of heaven.

The Responsorial Psalm this weekend reminds us it is Christ who rescues us. As we gather to the altar this weekend, we sing "All the Earth" as the opening hymn, which compliments this psalm. We are reminded that yes, we are to continuously sing our praise to God. The offertory and communion hymns resonate from the Gospel this weekend. Jesus directly states to those who He heals, "Do not be afraid, just have faith." How many times do we ourselves need to be reminded of that? As we review the texts of the common hymns "You are Mine" and "Be Not Afraid," amongst whatever pain or sickness we or others may be battling, let this be our prayer for the upcoming week. It is Jesus who lifts us from fear.

He tells us, too, not to fear, for He is with us. It is our faith that saves us, the same faith that the woman who touched Jesus' clothes in the Gospel today had. She trusted in Him. So let us also praise Him, as our psalm acclaims: "I will praise you, Lord, for you have rescued me."

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic</u> Church:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.






