


A Note from our Director of Music

Last week, our readings centered on how because of sin, sickness and death entered the world. We heard of a few accounts of people who came to him sick and in need, and because of their faith he helped them. This week, it's almost a complete 180 degree turn as where Jesus goes in the Gospel, people are treating him with hostility. The last lines in the Gospel this weekend says that He was unable to perform many signs there and they were offended at His presence.

This weekend's psalm reminds us that since we are not perfect, we need to plead for God's mercy. We must not lack faith, but rather turn to Him. This is echoed in the second reading in St. Paul's words telling us that in order to be strong in our faith, we must be content with weakness and insult on earth. The rest of our music this weekend invites us to gather for our Sunday obligation remembering it is Christ who strengthens us. In the opening hymn, "We Gather Together," the line "we are His holy people whose freedom He won," reminds us that He came down to earth to win us freedom from sin and death. Unlike those in the Gospel, we should be coming to Him, not questioning His authority but accepting that He is the Savior. Our offertory hymn, "I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say" consoles us that, if we come to Him and seek Him in faith that He will refresh us with living waters, and lay our cares upon Him. It is the sacrament of the altar that we partake of, the "Communion of Love" which we sing of at communion time, which binds us all together as Catholics. This is the gift which strengthens us, the gift of Christ Himself, the unblemished offering.

The Prophet Ezekiel foreshadows the entire weekend's theme in the first reading, warning that to be a prophet, we encounter those who may be obstinate of heart. Jesus encountered this when He was in His ministry, and we know that it is not always easy to live our faith. Let us turn to the Lord this week, not questioning his authority, but rather, pleading for His mercy; living by example so that all people, like our opening hymn concludes, "may grow in knowledge, in faith, hope, and love."

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic</u> Church:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.




