

A Note from our Director of Music

Our Sunday celebration of the Eucharist and the life and teachings of Jesus could never have been possible without the *fiat* of his mother, Mary. Because of her "yes" to God, we are able to receive her Son in the Sacraments. This weekend, we honor Mary in a special way, as the patroness of our basilica under the title of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Marian devotions originated in the early Church and continue to expand through the centuries as more people turn to her powerful intercession, as is evident by her many apparitions. This is also true for Marian hymns, which flourish in many traditions, languages, and forms.

Jean Langlais (1907-1991) was a blind organist and composer in France during the twentieth century. His most prominent job was at St. Clotilde in Paris, where he succeeded Cesar Franck and Charles Tournemire, two famous composers. Many of his works are deeply spiritual and were rooted in his Catholic faith. His Trois Paraphrases Gregoriennes is a testament to the love he had for the Gregorian chant melodies he learned as a choir boy. The second movement of this suite, the Ave Maria. Ave Maris Stella, shows Langlais' devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary bringing out two ancient melodies. To open the piece, while imitated in the strings, the full statement of the Ave Maria comes to us in a flute sound. In the next section, where "pray for us sinners" would be, is full of agitation. This suppresses into the Ave Maris Stella, heard on a trumpet sound with a celestial mystical accompaniment. The piece ends as it began, with soft strings and the flute restating the original Gregorian Ave Maria theme. This work is our prelude this weekend.

As we pray to, sing to, and celebrate Mary this weekend, may we turn toward her and ask for her help. As our beloved parish hymn *Immacolata* prays, though we are sinners, we are still her children and must ask for her intercession. I want to, in a special way, thank our instrumentalists, cantors, and our basilica choir joined with St. Anthony of Padua choir members for making our Masses extra special this weekend.

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic</u> <u>Church:</u>

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
