





A Note from our Director of Music

Saint Augustine said it best: "Singing is for the one who loves. Music is therefore a sign of God's love for us and of our love for Him. In this sense, it is very personal. But unless music sounds, it is not music, and whenever it sounds, it is accessible to others. By its very nature song has both an individual and a communal dimension. Thus, it is no wonder that singing together in church expresses so well the sacramental presence of God to His people."

Singing is an integral part of our Mass. Each weekend, we come to Mass and sing psalms, hymns, and chants as praise to God, His Son, and our Spiritual Mother, Mary. The Church in its structure of the Mass gives many opportunities to sing, but there are two parts of the Sunday celebration where singing must accompany a procession. Can you guess what they are?

I'll tell you. The first is the opening procession and the second is the communion procession. Both of these parts of the Mass have an antiphon located in the Roman Missal, but another hymn or seasonal psalm may be used in its place. The offertory procession does not have to contain a sung response; an instrumental piece, solo voice, choral piece, or even silence is appropriate at the offertory. The same is true about the conclusion of Mass. The Mass ends with the priest or deacon's dismissal and what takes place after that – whether a simple exit of the Liturgical ministers or a recessional – can be a closing hymn, a choral piece, an instrumental piece, or silence as the congregation exits.

This weekend, our readings and music focus on praise of our God and Trinity as it is God the Son, our Shepherd, who comforts us and teaches His people who are "like sheep without a shepherd." These summer Sundays in Ordinary Time can often seem very basic in terms of our faith, but we cannot let them slip by. Let us come to the altar each week ready to renew our faith, listen to what God calls us to do, and let our music sound and be accessible to others.

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apos-
- July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faith-

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
