A Note from our Director of Music

A familiar account occurs in today's Gospel as we hear of Jesus multiplying the two loaves and five fish to feed a multitude of people who have come to see Him. In the second book of Kings in the Old Testament first reading, this miracle is prefigured. The Psalm reminds us that we are always nourished by God, and our relationship with Him is strengthened by our love for one another and with our faith, coming to the Eucharistic table each weekend.

The choice of the music this weekend is twofold, both to echo these sentiments from the Scriptures presented to us and to greet our parishioners and guests in celebration as many of us attend our parish festival. Paul's words to us in the second reading of us living the Christian call to love is represented in our opening hymn, "Love Divine, All Loves Excelling" set to a common melody used for many texts, *Hyfrydol*. This melody also comes up in both this weekend's prelude and postlude. The offertory hymn, "God's Holy Mountain We Ascend," sums up the entire readings this weekend. We come to God's mountain to be refreshed each weekend. Where once the loaves were multiplied is now us recalling the festive meal each weekend, coming to the altar of God as Christians and as families this weekend for our parish festival as well. To latch onto our Italian parish culture, we thank God for all his blessings and graces in the communion hymn, "Ti Ringrazio, O Mio Signore." Since our parish is dedicated to the Blessed Mother, our second communion hymn used at our festival Masses, praises her in a special way sung in our Italian heritage. She is the mother who bore Jesus, our good and forgiving Lord who came forth from her womb to work miracles, including the multiplication of the loaves.

While we celebrate with friends and family this weekend on our parish grounds, may we never forget the true reason we are a community: that we are all here because of our faith in Christ Jesus. May God bless all of us as members of this great basilica during these festival days. *Buona Festa*, 2018!

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.




