

A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend's Gospel picks up very close to where last weekend's Gospel left off. Jesus continues his teachings on Himself as being the bread which comes down from heaven to satisfy our spiritual hungers. Elijah was strengthened by food for his journey in the first reading today, so too in the Gospel Jesus strengthens us by heavenly food for our spiritual journeys. As our Communion hymn acclaims, our hungry hearts are satisfied with this gift of finest wheat. The Psalm this weekend reminds us, too, that if we live in Christ, we will taste and see the Lord's goodness. Our Christian call to be bread to others is echoed by the second reading where Paul tells the Ephesians, and in turn us, to be imitators of Christ, living in love, kindness, compassion, and forgiveness. This message is summarized in this weekend's opening hymn, "Where Charity and Love Prevail."

As we continue our reflection in the Sunday readings about Christ as the bread of life, who nourishes us at Mass, two Gregorian chant melodies are presented this weekend whose texts relate to our spiritual banquet. O Sacrum Convivium, an ancient text acclaims: "O sacred banquet, in which Christ is received, the memory of his Passion is renewed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us." The offertory chant, Ave Verum Corpus states: "Hail true body, Born of the Virgin Mary; who has truly suffered, slaughtered on the cross for humanity. Whose side was pierced, pouring out water and blood. Be a foretaste for us during our ordeal of death."

Holy God, We Praise Thy Name, our closing hymn this weekend, is a hymn of praise and thanksgiving which takes place at the conclusion of Eucharistic benediction. As we come to the altar this weekend, let us bow before the Lord of all and praise His name, He who is our bread and nourishment for the week ahead.

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.




