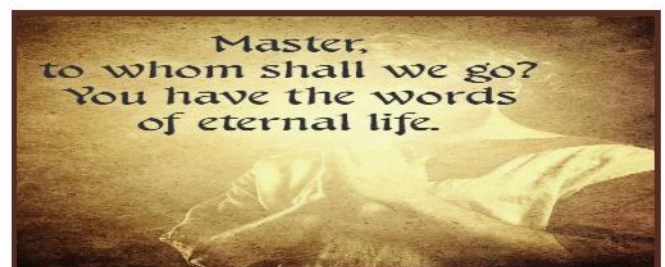

**Craig's Corner**

**A Note from our Director of Music**

“God has bestowed upon his people the gift of song. God dwells within each human person, in the place where music takes its source. Indeed, God, the giver of song, is present whenever his people sing his praises.”

I opened last week’s bulletin with this line, which comes from the opening of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops’ document, *Sing to the Lord*, stating how important using our gift of music, no matter how big or small it may be, to sing God’s praises. I then went on to discuss the different parts of Mass, one of which was antiphons. Antiphons are refrains of text which are direct quotations of scripture or psalms, found as part of the Mass for the opening or communion rites. This weekend, we begin Mass with the entrance antiphon, taken from Psalm 86. Part of this text reads, “Save the servant who trusts in you, my God.” In this weekend’s Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples that since not everyone believes in Him, only some will inherit His kingdom. We must, as the psalm states, trust in our God and believe in His name.

Jesus also mentions that His words are Spirit and life. The text of our offertory hymn, “O Breathe on Me, O Breath of God” prays that the words of Christ and the Spirit fill us with life and make us one with Christ. This includes making our will one with Christ, not being selfish, but rather to be one with Christ who has the words of everlasting life. Our communion hymn, “O Sacrament Most Holy” takes these words and connects them with our celebration of the Eucharist. In the Book of Joshua, the people he summons gather to serve only the Lord. This is our Lord who brought the Israelites out of the land of Egypt, and for us sacrificed His life and gives us His precious blood and body to become our sacred feast. Now, we too, like Peter should acclaim that Jesus is “the Holy One of God.”

*From the Rector*

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the **Catechism of the Catholic Church**:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord’s prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
