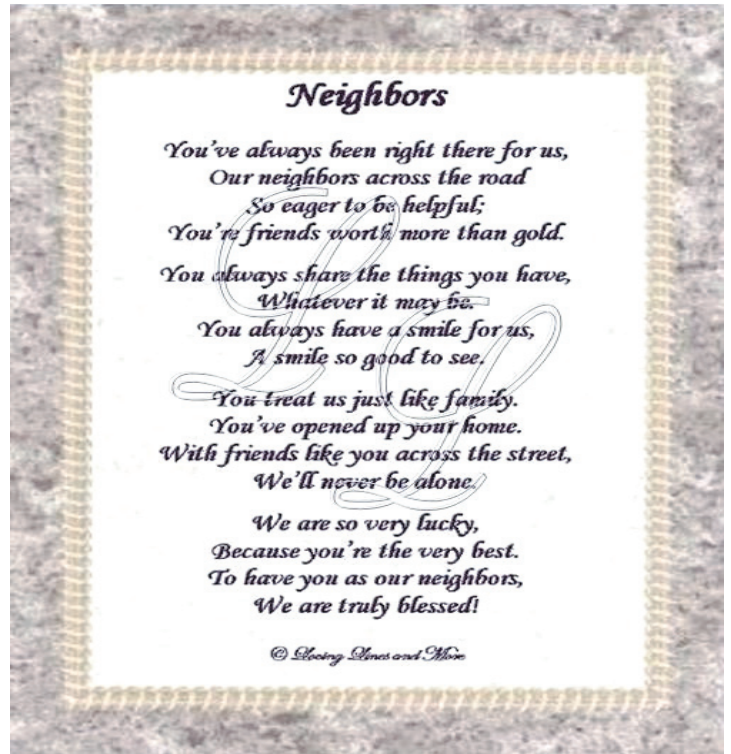

John 6: 51-58

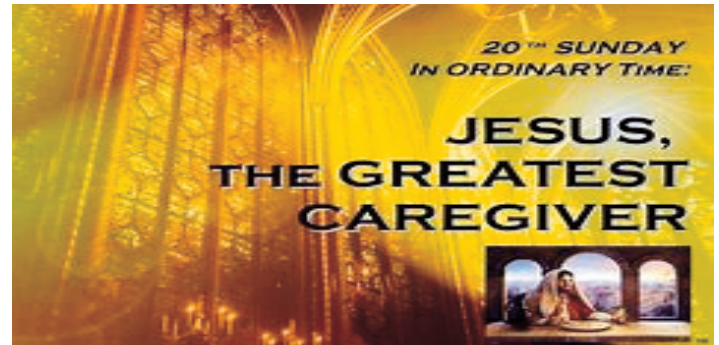
